About Prof. Brainard:

Professor, Neurology; Director, Light Research Program; Jefferson Medical College;
Thomas Jefferson University; Philadelphia, Pennsylvania.

Dr. Brainard's academic work has been concerned with the effects of light on biological and behavioral responses of animals and humans. His research on the effects of light have been supported by grants from the National Institutes of Health, NASA, FDA, as well as Philips, OSRAM and other industrial and private sources. He has authored over 80 original research articles and 45 book chapters and edited 6 books or monographs including 3 IESNA/ANSI standards.

Dr. Brainard chaired the IESNA Photobiology Committee for for ten years, is currently a member of the IESNA Light and Health Committee, and is currently Division Six Director for the International Commission on Illumination (USNC/CIE).

During his career, Dr. Brainard has taught neuroanatomy and neurophysiology to over 5,000 medical and graduate students. He is currently working on lighting for the international space station and other, future space habitats. In addition he is testing advanced lighting designs for treating patients with winter depression or S.A.D. (seasonal affective disorder).
